Anti Ragging, Discipline and Grievance Redressal Committee

2022-23

A. INTRODUCTION

The College has constituted the Anti Ragging Committee for the academic year 2022-23. The Committee aims to prevent the menace of ragging and foster healthy interpersonal relations among students in the campus. Ragging is strictly forbidden in or outside the college campus. All students shall familiarize themselves with rules/regulations/guidelines on code of conduct, anti-ragging measures and discipline of the College. All 'new comers' are counselled by the Principal regarding disciplined behaviour to be maintained by the students. Even the faculty act as mentors and counsel the students from time to time. If any student has any grievance in the nature of ragging, including any kind of harassment, the same can be brought to the notice of the Chairman of the Committee for necessary action and redressal.

B. OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMITTEE

1. To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the menace of ragging including any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in undisciplined activities by any student.
2. To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
3. To promptly deal with the incidents of ragging brought to the notice of the Principal.

C. FUNCTIONS OF COMMITTEE

1. To consider the complaints received from the students and conduct enquiry and submit report to the Anti- Ragging Committee along with punishment recommended for the offenders;
2. Conduct workshops and orient students on ragging menace.
3. To provide students the information pertaining to the faculty identified to receive complaints/distress calls;
4. To take all necessary measures for prevention of Ragging inside the Campus/ Hostels.

b. Role of the chairman:

On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti Ragging Committee or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case of ragging is made out and if so, either on her own or through a member of the committee proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions.

D. ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING:

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed herein under:

- a) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Committee.
- b) The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the enquiry Committee, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
- c) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- d) Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f) Cancellation of admission.
- g) Rustication /Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- h) Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
